An ODFW Reminder to Limited Fish Sellers

Notify ODFW of Change of Vessel or Port Designation

Call the Fish Ticket Section of ODFW if you are going to sell from a vessel or at a port other than the one listed on your Limited Fish Seller Application. The Fish Ticket number in Salem is (503)947-6247

Begin Your Fish Ticket Prior to Selling Fish

Notice of sales is required prior to selling. However, regulations provide that notice is given if:

- you are at the location designated on the application and
- you have started the fish ticket that lists the following:
 - vessel information
 - port designation
 - dealer number and
 - an estimate of the number and weight of fish on board entered at the top of the "Dealer Use" column

You-the Limited Fish Seller-Must Sell Your Fish

The permit allows the fisher who holds the permit to tsell fish to the ultimate consumer. It does not allow sales by a deck hand or operator who does not have a permit

Give a Signed Numbered Receipt with Each Sale to the Ultimate Consumer

Prepare a numbered receipt at the time of each sale. Give a signed copy to the public buyer and retain a copy for your records. The receipt must include:

- date of the sale
 - species name
 - weight in pounds
 - price
 - number of fish or shellfish and
 - vessel name

-Important-

Keep a copy of the receipt on board for six months and available for three years.

At the end of each day, record in the "Dealer Use" column on the fish ticket, the date, total pounds, and price of each species sold.

At the end of all sales for the trip, complete the fish ticket, entering the date of final sale and the total pounds sold by species in the pounds column and the price per pound.

Record Take-Home Pounds on a Numbered Receipt

Use the same price that you are selling to the public. This needs to be included in your daily sales on your fish ticket. The pounds and price need to be recorded in the ticket area above the Take Home Header and in the section below.

Send Completed Fish Tickets in Promptly

- Fish tickets reporting Salmon must be forwarded within **4 consecutive days** following the day of final sale for the trip.
- Fish tickets reporting **Other Fish and Shellfish** must be forwarded within **10** working days following the day of final sale for the trip.

Send Your Monthly Report and Landing Fee Payment Before the 20th of the Next Month Following Month of Sales

List the fish tickets used during the month on the monthly report.
