

EFM Fort Rock Access Area

The EFM Fort Rock Area is a "Welcome to Hunt" Open Fields Access Area. It is a cooperative program between EFM Inc., an affiliate of EcoTrust, and the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's Access and Habitat Program to maintain public hunting access on private lands and to increase access to public lands.

All Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife Regulations and Seasons Apply.

Hunting on Private Land is a privilege, not a right. Private land hunting opportunities will remain in the future only if the property and rights of private landowners are respected! Abuse it and you will lose it!

Area Regulations:

- Please stay on open roads. No cross country travel.
- 4-wheel drive vehicles are recommended roads are not maintained for highway vehicles.
- Roads are not guaranteed to be open.
- No Camping or Campfires.
- Leave gates as found.
- Follow fire protection regulations and seasonal restrictions. Vehicles should be equipped with a round pointed shovel, an axe or Pulaski and a fire extinguisher not less than 5 pounds.
- EFM is cooperator in ODFW's Cabin Lake/Silver Lake Road Closure the property is closed to motor vehicles access annually from Dec 1st to March 31st.
